By now, you should have a fairly well-developed thesis statement. Your thesis should include the following: your topic, your argument, your “because” clause, your answer to the “what’s the point question,” and a suggestion of your organization.

To this end, thesis statements should be emailed to me in the text of an email (i.e. not as an attachment) by the above due date and time. I will email you back both a confirmation that I have received your email, and then my comments.

This assignment will be worth one quiz grade for your draft and one quiz grade for responding to your classmates’ drafts.
