

Revision Requirements for Lisa Hager's ENG 1001 Class

You may revise any major writing assignment in the class as many times as you want or until you get an A. All revisions must be submitted before **Wednesday, August 8th**. However, because the summer is so short and intense, I highly recommend that you revise your papers as soon as possible after I return them to you. Your revisions will not be very good if you try to do them all at the end of the semester.

Failure to meet any of these guidelines will result in your assignment grade remaining the same

All content and format revisions must follow these guidelines:

- Your revised paper must be submitted in the correct format for that particular assignment.
- You must have at least one additional peer-review session, writing center tutor session, or conference with me about your paper.
- You must fix or address all of the marginal comments that I have written on your draft
- You must do more than simply address the comments that I have written in the margins of your paper. Instead, you should pay special attention to my comments at the end of your paper and revise your paper as a whole.
- Your revision must be turned into me in a two pocket folder. The contents of this folder should include the following:
 1. Your revised paper
 2. Your additional peer review sheet
 3. Your original graded paper with your original peer review sheet attached

All format-only revisions must follow these guidelines:

- Your revised paper must be submitted in the correct format for that particular assignment.
- Your revision must be turned into me in a two pocket folder. The contents of this folder should include the following:
 1. Your revised paper
 2. Your already-graded paper with your original peer review sheet attached
