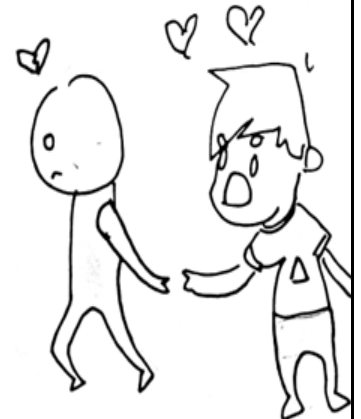

## A GIRL

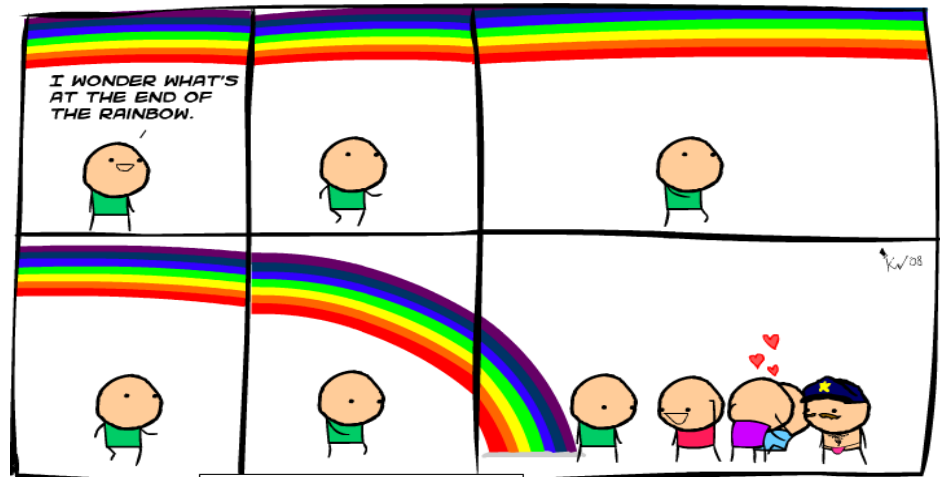
Michael Field

## In Praise of Shame

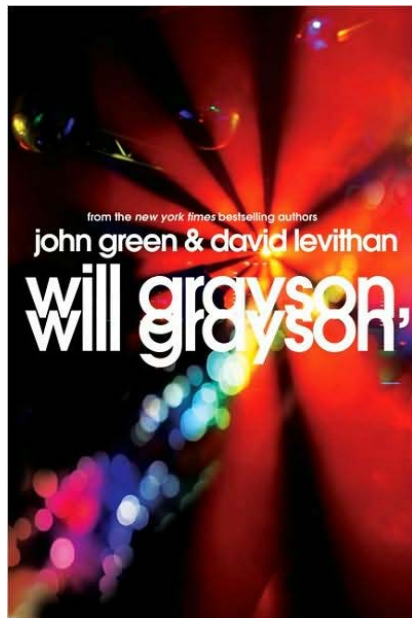
Lord Alfred Douglass

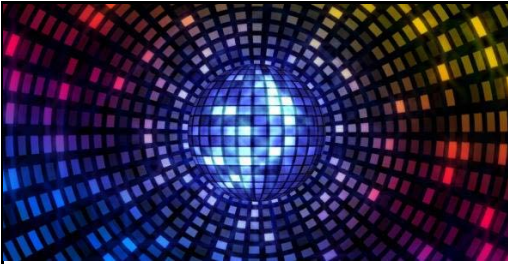
